Hi George:

The 11/12 morning ABWR SC meeting may need to be rescheduled as the safety culture PRA SC meeting is now all day (instead of afternoon only). We will lose 2 of the 4 ABWR SC members to this all day meeting. Also, Dr. Abdel-Khalik may not want to hold the ABWR meeting under a low participation because the idea was to get as many members as possible (not just the ABWR SC) given the general nature of this information briefing. Tanny was checking.

The November FC briefing is still there, unless the workload for this meeting gets so large that this info brief gets killed. I will try to remind everybody that these two info briefs are to help the members review the upcoming STP COLA SER chapters.

There is no minimum time between a SC and the FC letter writing that I know of. But it is prudent to allow some time (a few weeks, if possible) for the members to review the material and for the Chairman to start drafting a letter for the FC.

I have a question for you: I was told that the final SER for RCOLA (=STP COLA) is due in 9/2011. Then why do you need a letter from the ACRS in June 2010? I was wondering what is scheduled in this time gap? Is the 6/10 ACRS letter going to be on chapters of the SER with open items or the SER with no open items before a final SER is prepared?
