Answer 1. – A delegation of authority letter is attached.

Answer 2. – Training for individuals that are proposed as users on MACTEC's NRC Material License is commensurate with their level of involvement with radioactive materials and their level of experience and qualifications (consistent with NUREG-1556, Appendix H). Most individuals identified in the license are users of low-activity, response-check type radioactive materials, and do not manage remediation sites where larger inventories of radioactive material may be present. When projects are planned where the management of large quantities of radioactive material (e.g., more than just response-check sources) will be necessary under the MACTEC Materials license, a MACTEC senior-level Health Physicist is identified as the project RSO and has the responsibilities for management of the radioactive materials for that project. Regardless, individuals authorized to use or manage the use of radioactive materials under the MACTEC license are required to complete MACTEC's Radiological Services Division Required Training and sign an acknowledgement form indicating completion of the training (forms attached for three individuals). This training includes a self-performed review of MACTEC's NRC Material License, Radiation Protection Program, accompanying program procedures and an interview with the MACTEC RSO.
