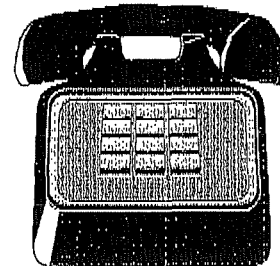

As Mr. Rima is currently out of the country on business, I've been asked to respond to the two questions; delegation of authority letter and training/experience for Mr. Gordon Madison, Mr. Robert Posner, Mr. Joel Doebele and Ms. Carrie Bloink, being added to the MACTEC Materials license as radioactive material users. You indicated in your fax that a response to your inquiries is acceptable via email, so please accept this email as the response.

Answer 1. – A delegation of authority letter is attached.

Answer 2. – Training for individuals that are proposed as users on MACTEC's NRC Material License is commensurate with their level of involvement with radioactive materials and their level of experience and qualifications (consistent with NUREG-1556, Appendix H). Most individuals identified in the license are users of low-activity, response-check type radioactive materials, and do not manage remediation sites where larger inventories of radioactive material may be present. When projects are planned where the management of large quantities of radioactive material (e.g., more than just response-check sources) will be necessary under the MACTEC Materials license, a MACTEC senior-level Health Physicist is identified as the project RSO and has the responsibilities for management of the radioactive materials for that project. Regardless, individuals authorized to use or manage the use of radioactive materials under the MACTEC license are required to complete MACTEC's Radiological Services Division Required Training and sign an acknowledgement form indicating completion of the training (forms attached for three individuals). This training includes a self-performed review of MACTEC's NRC Material License, Radiation Protection Program, accompanying program procedures and an interview with the MACTEC RSO.

Below are there qualifications and level of experience for the individuals identified above:

- Mr. Madison is a CHP and RRPT with over 30 years experience in the nuclear industry. He joined MACTEC in November 2009.
- Mr. Doebele taught at the U.S. Navy's Naval Nuclear Power School for four years prior to joining MACTEC and holds a Master's Degree in Health Physicist from Oregon State University. He joined MACTEC in February 2010.
- Mr. Posner holds a Bachelor's Degree in Environmental Sciences with three years of radiological survey experience. He joined MACTEC in August 2008.
- Ms. Bloink holds a Master's Degree in Health Physicist from Purdue University. She worked for Purdue University for 1½ years in their Radiological Environmental Management section. Ms. Bloink joins MACTEC on June 7, 2010 and hence no Training Acknowledgement form for her.

MACTEC Development Corporation (MACTEC) is providing written notification, as required by Materials License, Number 05-27748-01, Docket Number 030-36204, that all licensed activities at a temporary job site, have been completed. The specific site location is: MACTEC Office, 9177 Sky Park Court, San Diego, California, 92123.

MACTEC was granted Reciprocal Recognition of License on 08/30/2010 for use of its NRC license in the State of California by the Radiologic Health Branch, California Department of Public Health. Enclosed with this notification letter is a copy of the Request for Release of Reciprocity letter submitted to the State of California on October 18, 2010.

MACTEC implemented a series of laboratory tests of concrete material extracted from the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant, starting on August 30th, 2010. Completed activities (concrete sample analysis) consisted of receipt of, via exempt quantity shipment, approximately 29 pounds of solid concrete material, extracted from the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Station on or shortly after August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010. MACTEC personnel performed characterization tests and analyses on the material. Upon completion of the tests, concrete material and waste generated during the material analysis was shipped back to Kewaunee Power Station and received on 10/13/2010. No further licensed activities are planned at the temporary job site. No licensed radioactive material remains at the temporary job site as documented by radiological surveys performed between 09/21/2010 and 10/12/2010.
