CONFIRMATORY ORDER DATED JULY 28, 2009

Dear Mr. Hackett:

The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated November 3, 2010, which provided a description of the curriculum of subjects covered during a training session that you conducted on the transportation and receipt of radioactive material. Your letter also included a list of individuals who were in attendance at the training. Based on our review of your letter, we concluded that the training was conducted in accordance with Confirmatory Order IA-09-026 (Order), and fulfilled item 1.c. of the Order.

Based on our review of your responses to all of the terms of the agreement that are described in the Order, we have concluded that you completed all required actions. Please note, however, that item 2 of the Order remains in effect. Item 2 requires that you notify the National Health Physics Program (NHPP) and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) within 30 days from the point at which, for any reason, you are unable to perform any of your responsibilities of the Radiation Safety Officer.

In conclusion, we have determined that you have met all of the terms of the Order, and have no further questions at this time.

In accordance with Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.
