I have some questions about the evaluating the pull off strength of coatings in this Reg. Guide.


I think it is important to designate a specific test method(e.g., ASTM D4541 type II, or III.. / method B, or C..) prior to determining the acceptability of a specific adhesion value.

Section 4 of this Reg. Guide ;

Q1. In the discussion of ASTM D4541-09, do you mean the tester type II(test method B) is only available for this guidance?

Q2. In the discussion of ASTM D7234-05, which portable pull-off adhesion testers are available for this guidance?

Q3. In the discussion of ASTM D5144-08 that specifying the adhesion property as a top-level ASTM standards, which instrument is required to meet the requirement of minimum pull-off strength 200psi on steel and concrete substrate?
