The purpose of this modification is to:

Section 2.0 BACKGROUND, is hereby replaced in its entirety with the text:

IAS consists of several Commercial Off the Shelf (COTS) products loaded, tested and operated on a separate subnet that is capable of accessing the entire NRC network. The COTS products to be installed on hardened servers include but are not limited to: digital forensics tools, incident response tracking and management tools, data loss prevention tools, Secure Content Automation Protocol (SCAP) tools, vulnerability management and scanning tools, and other various security software and applications already in use at the NRC that will be used by RichMAR to monitor for vulnerabilities and provide quality baseline data to enhance to overall deployment of the IAS. Each of these products provides a necessary automated Information Technology (IT) Security capability for the Computer Security Office (CSO). The greatest benefit of having this suite of tools is that it will provide a real-time situational awareness capability to the members of the CSO Cyber Security Awareness (CSA) Team. Rather than relying on other NRC organizations to provide filtered information to the CSO/CSA, the combination of these capabilities will enhance the mission of the CSA and allow it to perform its essential duties autonomously. The implementation of this capability will provide the platform to receive critical Cyber security information first hand and unfiltered. The contractor will support the CSO in the deployment, operations and maintenance of the system.
