SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION NO. 36-23875-01E

Dear Mr. Szpak,

This letter is in response to your letter dated October 7, 2010, requesting renewal of your NRC Exempt Distribution License No. 36-23875-01E. Your letter states that the only change to your license is the change in the name of the manufacturer of your sources. In order to continue our review we ask that you provide the following additional information:

1. Confirm that you have reviewed the documents previously submitted to the NRC and referenced in your license to determine if the information is up to date and accurately represents your current licensed activities and products. Identify by date, those documents that are applicable and those that are out-of-date or superseded, and indicate any changes necessary to reflect the current program. Please note that out of date information could include old addresses, superseded procedures, etc.
2. Please provide a copy of your current State of Oregon Materials Possession License.
3. For your information, Eckert & Ziegler Analytics has applied for an exempt distribution license in order to distribute the VZ-623, C-14 source. As of the date of this letter the exempt distribution license has not been approved. In accordance with 10 CFR 32.18 please confirm that the C-14 source used in Met One products is not incorporated into any manufactured or assembled commodity, or device intended for commercial distribution prior to being introduced into the Met One devices.
4. Please identify the units used in the VZ-623-001 drawing submitted with your renewal letter dated October 7, 2010.

In addition to the renewal of your license, your registration certificates NR-1124-D-101-E and NR-1124-D-102-E will be amended to reflect the name change of the manufacturer of your sources.

Please submit the requested information within 30 days of the date of this letter. If we do not receive your reply within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we will consider your request to terminate the license as having been abandoned by you. This action would be without prejudice to the resubmission of another request with the required information.
