- SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF NOVEMBER 29, 2010, PUBLIC MEETING WITH TVA REGARDING EMERGENCY ACTION LEVEL PLANS FOR THE TVA NUCLEAR PLANTS

On November 29, 2010, a Category 1 public meeting was held between Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and representatives of TVA. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the pre-submittal of emergency action level plans revised from Nuclear Management and Resources Council, Incorporated (NUMARC)/National Environmental Studies Project (NESP)-007 "Methodology of Development of Emergency Action Levels," Revision 2, January 1992, to Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) document NEI 99-01, "Methodology for Development of Emergency Action Levels," Revision 5, February 2008, for all TVA nuclear plants: Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant, Units 1, 2, and 3; Sequoyah Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2; and Watts Bar Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. The enclosure contains a list of attendees.

Highlights from the Meeting

- TVA plans to submit emergency plan (EP) changes from NUMARC/NESP-007 to NEI 99-01 Revision 5 for the TVA fleet.
- TVA plans to send the EP submittal in December 2010 or January 2011.
- TVA plans to implement the EP changes following the issuance of the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant, Unit 2 operating license.
- The NRC staff said the review of the EP submittal will typically take 1 year.

No commitments or regulatory decisions were made by the NRC staff during the meeting.
