RE: NRC License #21-00943-03 – New Authorized User & Minor Changes

To Whom It May Concern:

We request to amend our NRC License No. 21-00943-03 to add Oneil Lee, MD as an authorized user (AU) in accordance with 10 CFR 35. We request that this evaluation be completed February 1, 2011. We are also requesting some minor changes to correct, clarify and update our license

Dr. Lee is certified by the American Board of Radiology in Diagnostic Radiology (AU Eligible) in 2007 and the American Board of Nuclear Medicine in 2008. In addition, he was recently authorized by the Washington University, St. Louis, under its broad scope license issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission as an Authorized User for those uses authorized in 10 CFR 35.100, 35.200, and 35.300.

Based on his training and experience in accordance with the definition of an authorized user in 10 CFR 35.2, we seek authorization for Dr. Lee to perform all duties of an AU for 10 CFR Parts 35.100, 35.200, and 35.300. A copy of his ABR certificate and current Washington University license authorization are enclosed. His credentials have been reviewed and approved by Management and the Radiation Safety Committee of the St. Joseph Mercy Health System in September 2010.

The following amendments are requested to correct and clarify our NRC license.

- a) Please remove Milton Gross, MD as an authorized user.
- b) Please remove the authorization for 10 CFR 35.300 uses at our St. Joseph Mercy Hospital–Saline, 400 W. Russell St., Saline, MI, location of use in License Condition 10.C. This hospital no longer has in-patient facilities to support patients with therapeutic amounts of radionuclides who cannot be released.
- c) Please remove authorization for the multiple sources of unsealed Y-90 liquid sources authorized in License Subitem 6.G, 7.G, and 8.G. This was for nonhuman use to perform calibration of a dose calibrator. Current science makes this no longer needed. It has not been done in over seven years, and no future need is expected. Accordingly, License Condition 9.G needs to be removed.

- d) License Condition 12.E references a Subitem 6.I. There is no such Subitem. We believe this is supposed to reference the blood irradiator currently in Subitem 6.H.
- e) License Condition 12.C specifies a single authorized medical physicist (AMP) as the authorized user for non-medical use of our HDR (Subitem 6.F), Y-90 unsealed source (Subitem 6.G), and blood irradiator (Subitem 6.H).

 This Condition should not include the HDR (Subitem 6.F) because all three AMPs are authorized for these activities in License Condition 12.D. This should not include Y-90 unsealed source (Subitem 6.G) because it is being removed as requested in (b) above. We understand that the NRC requires named individuals be specified for the non-medical use of the blood irradiator listed in License Condition 12.C. Please list Matthew McMullen, MS (currently stated) and Ralph P. Lieto, MSE (current RSO) as the authorized users for this device. Both individuals have completed all requirements for unescorted access to this device.

Your use of NRC-licensed radioactive materials at this institution is authorized by NRC License No. 24-00167-11, a Broad Scope Type A medical license. Your use of state-regulated radioactive materials at this institution is authorized by Missouri Registration Nos. 2793.


