Dear Sir or Madam:

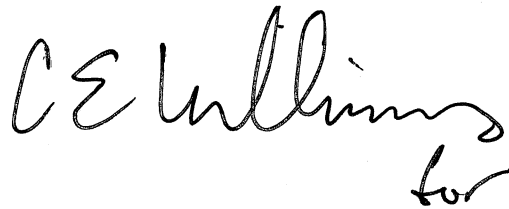
In Reference 1, NERC states that the NRC staff will articulate the Commission's decision regarding jurisdiction of the continuity of power, balance of plant systems structures and components in the near future. The letter further states that NERC expects each licensee to provide its updated cyber security plan in accordance with a schedule to be provided by the NRC.

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Consistent with the revised NERC expectation, Southern California Edison will provide a supplement to the SONGS Cyber Security Plan (Reference 2) in accordance with a schedule to be provided by the NRC. This new schedule to provide a supplement to the NRC replaces the prior schedule to supplement the SONGS Cyber Security Plan on or before November 30, 2010 (Reference 3).
