The purpose of this modification is to:

Section B.1 – Brief Description of Work

1. Objective (beginning of second paragraph should read as follows)

[IAS consists of several commercial-off-the-shelf products: a digital forensics tool, an incident response database, a data loss prevention tool, Secure Content Automation Protocol (SCAP) tools, and vulnerability management and scanning tools for NRC computing devices and web sites. In addition to the tools listed above, the CSO also has access to numerous security applications from its partner organizations. The contractors will be granted access to these and other tools for the purpose of monitoring Cyber events in order to enhance the CSO's Cyber Situational Awareness. IAS will be used to continually assess, validate and report on the security posture of the internal Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) information systems and will be supported through the introduction of new sub-systems as the CSO expands IAS functionality. This Statement of Work outlines the tasks needed to ensure this new system is deployed effectively.

3. Personnel Requirements (third (3) paragraph)

The Contractor's personnel shall have in depth understanding of the following:

Digital forensics tools, incident response tracking and management tools, data loss prevention tools, Secure Content Automation Protocol (SCAP) tools, vulnerability management and scanning tools, and other various security software and applications.

Security Expertise: computer and network forensics, secure baseline configurations, network engineering, network monitoring, Intrusion Detection Systems (IDS), Firewalls, Virtual Private Networking (VPN), Wireless, Remote Access Systems (RAS), Malware, and Spyware.
