On September 29, 2010, and November 4, 2010, a U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) inspector conducted an inspection at your facility. The inspection results were discussed with you and members of your staff during an exit meeting held at the conclusion of the on-site inspection.

During this inspection, the NRC staff examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to public health and safety, compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations, and compliance with the conditions of your license.
