Status of Recommendations

Recommendation 1:	Develop an NRC Management Directive to provide the management controls needed to ensure that NRC produces credible GPRA documents.
Agency Response Dated October 21, 2010:	As previously indicated, the recommendations are being addressed as part of the revision to Management Directive (MD) and Handbook 4.7, <i>"NRC Long Range Planning, Programming and Budget Formulation."</i> We have decided to modify our approach to the replacement of the MD and Handbook in order to improve policy communication, organization and achieve agency consensus on the policies covered. We will replace it with three separate MDs: <i>"Strategic Planning Process"</i> (new); <i>"Budget Formulation"</i> (MD 4.7); and, <i>"Performance Management"</i> (new). Additionally, MD 4.4, <i>"Management Controls,"</i> is currently being revised and re-titled, <i>"Internal Control."</i> This MD establishes and assigns responsibility for controls and assurances over NRC program and processes. Currently, the revision to MD 4.7 is on hold due to consultation with the Chairman.
OIG Analysis:	The proposed corrective action addresses the intent of OIG's recommendation. This recommendation will be closed when OIG receives a copy of the final relevant management directives that include management controls needed to ensure that NRC produces credible GPRA documents.
