

In Reference 1, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) states that the NRC staff will articulate the Commission's decision regarding jurisdiction of the continuity of power, balance of plant systems, structures, and components in the near future. The letter further states that NERC expects each licensee to provide its updated cyber security plan in accordance with a schedule to be provided by the NRC.

Consistent with the revised NERC expectation, STP Nuclear Operating Company will provide a supplement to the South Texas Project Cyber Security Plan (Reference 2) in accordance with a schedule to be provided by the NRC. This new schedule to provide a supplement to the NRC replaces the prior schedule to supplement the South Texas Project Cyber Security Plan on or before November 30, 2010 (Reference 3).

This letter contains no new regulatory commitments.
