Dear Sir or Madam:

By means of the letter in Reference 1, Luminant Generation Company LLC (Luminant Power) identified to the NRC the Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant (CPNPP) balance of plant systems, structures and components (SSCs) considered important to safety with respect to the NRC's cyber security regulation. In the Reference 1 letter, Luminant Power also stated the intention to supplement the CPNPP Cyber Security Plan (Reference 2) to clarify the scope of systems described in Section 2.1, "Scope and Purpose," with a target submittal date of November 30, 2010.

Subsequent to the letter in Reference 1, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) has updated their requirement to submit a revised cyber security plan to the NRC (Reference 3). Consistent with the revised NERC expectation, Luminant Power will provide a supplement to the CPNPP Cyber Security Plan in accordance with a schedule to be provided by the NRC.


