SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF NOVEMBER 15, 2010 MEETING TO DISCUSS THE
PROPOSED IMPLEMENTATION DATES OF THE DRAFT EMERGENCY
PREPAREDNESS FINAL RULE

On November 15, 2010, a category 3 public meeting was held by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) at the Hilton Washington DC/ Rockville Hotel & Executive Meeting Center, 1750 Rockville Pike, Rockville, MD 20852. In attendance were industry representatives, Non-governmental Organizations, State and local governmental representatives, and interested stakeholders. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the implementation timeline for the draft Emergency Preparedness Final Rule as proposed by the NRC and FEMA and to solicit informal stakeholder feedback.

A summary of the meeting discussion and a list of meeting attendees are enclosed. 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SUMMARY OF NOVEMBER 15, 2010 MEETING TO DISCUSS THE PROPOSED IMPLEMENTATION DATES OF THE DRAFT EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS FINAL RULE

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff is engaged in rulemaking to enhance emergency preparedness (EP) regulations and guidance. The purpose of this meeting was to provide an opportunity for the NRC, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and the public to address issues and concerns regarding the implementation dates that are currently in the draft EP final rule. Some stakeholders were not able to attend the meeting and provided their feedback via letters and emails. The feedback received, including letters and emails, and the meeting transcript can be accessed at www.regulations.gov, Docket ID: NRC-2008-0122.

During the meeting, representatives from the NRC and FEMA discussed the proposed implementation dates included in the draft final rule and supporting EP program guidance. The NRC presented a detailed implementation matrix outlining the implementation periods from the proposed rule, the implementation periods requested by external stakeholders during the public comment period, as well as any implementation period changes presented in the draft EP final rule. Attendees were given the opportunity to address additional factors that may impact their ability to address the regulatory and guidance changes. This meeting also gave the NRC and FEMA staff the opportunity to answer questions and solicit feedback.

From the 11 topics discussed at the meeting, we received feedback on eight of the topics. The NRC staff in coordination with FEMA will consider the feedback from the meeting and use it to inform the decision process on whether to further adjust the implementation dates in the final rule. The final rule is scheduled to be published in 2011. At this time, the NRC and FEMA are planning to hold public meetings to discuss the implementation of the rule changes.
