Update to Notification Letter Designating PVNGS Balance of Plant  
Systems, Structures, and Components (SSCs) within the Cyber  
Security Rule Scope**

In Reference 1, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) states that the NRC staff will articulate the Commission's decision regarding jurisdiction of the continuity of power balance of plant SSCs in the near future. The letter further states that NERC expects each licensee to provide its updated cyber security plan in accordance with a schedule to be provided by the NRC.

Consistent with the revised NERC expectation, APS will provide a supplement to the PVNGS Cyber Security Plan (Reference 2) in accordance with a schedule to be provided by the NRC. This new schedule to provide a supplement to the NRC replaces

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
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the prior schedule to supplement the PVNGS Cyber Security Plan on or before November 30, 2010 (Reference 3).
