Dear Sir or Madam:

On February 22, 2010 (Reference 1), Entergy Operations, Inc (Entergy) requested a license amendment change to modify Technical Specification (TS) 3/4.9.4, "Containment Building Penetrations," to allow alternative means of penetration closure during Core Alterations or irradiated fuel movement while in refueling operations. Additional improvements were also proposed to the refueling operations technical specifications consistent with Revision 3 of NUREG-1432, "Standard Technical Specifications Combustion Engineering Plants".

Attachment 1 to the above referenced letter provided a description to the proposed TS and TS Bases changes. The fourth bullet in Section 2 of this attachment made the following statement:

Revise TS 3.9.4.b to add "is" between "airlock" and "capable" and delete the asterisk () since the associated note is being moved to the Limiting Condition for Operation (LCO). This change is editorial and is not further discussed.*

However, consistent with other discussions and the actual TS and TS Bases changes, the asterisked note was moved to the TS Bases. This bullet should have read:

Revise TS 3.9.4.b to add "is" between "airlock" and "capable" and delete the asterisk () since the associated note is being removed from the Limiting Condition for Operation (LCO). This change is editorial and is not further discussed.*
