Dear Mr. Hickey:

This is in follow-up to the above referenced letter wherein we described Interstate Nuclear Services, Corp.'s proposed acquisition of Environmental Laundries, Inc., a subsidiary of Tri-State Industrial Laundries, Inc. We are requesting that Material License #31-21168-01 be amended to reflect Interstate Nuclear Services, Corp. as the licensee located at North Third Avenue, Royersford, Pennsylvania 19468, to take effect on 2/1/84.

Interstate Nuclear Services, Corp. has reviewed the above referenced material license and we agree to abide by all terms and conditions of the license including all supporting documents and procedures submitted previously by Tri-State Industrial Laundries of Utica, New York. The only other change we wish to make at this time is to add four more authorized users of radioactive material. These individuals are George J. Bakevich, M.Craig Connelly, Gregg A. Johnstone and Thomas B. Nally. A resume of training and experience is attached for each of these individuals.

Environmental Laundries, Inc. (a subsidiary of Tri-State Industrial Laundries, Inc.) is well aware of our intention to modify their materials license to reflect Interstate Nuclear Services, Corp. as the new owner and operator as of 2/1/84. As I had discussed previously, it is of vital importance to assure continuity of operations at this nuclear laundry facility. I will be in Washington on Wednesday, 1/11/84, with Gregg Johnstone, our Corporate Health Physicist. I will give you a call on the morning of the 11th and if you think a meeting is necessary or desirable, we will be available at any time during that day. We look forward to an early response to this amendment application so that we may adequately plan a smooth transition into our new facility.
