PROGRAM SCOPE

This licensee was a small medical institution (50-bed hospital) with authorization for materials in Sections 35.100 and 35.200. The nuclear medicine department was staffed with three technologists who performed approximately 150-190+ diagnostic nuclear medicine procedures each month. The licensee performed a full spectrum of diagnostic imaging studies. The licensee received unit doses from a local radiopharmacy. The licensee's consulting physicist audited the radiation safety program on a quarterly basis (last 9/28/2010, with no findings).

This inspection consisted of interviews with select licensee personnel; a review of select records; tour of the nuclear medicine department; and independent measurements. The inspector observed the administration of a resting cardiac nuclear medicine procedure. The inspection included observations of dose calibrator QA checks, security of byproduct material, use of personnel monitoring, and surveys.
