Just a couple of comments:

In the last whereas, standard form is to insert a numeral after the number of pages is spelled out. Like this:

"consisting of seven (7) pages"

Also, the following statement needs to be on the top of the signature page:

**"Signatures:** In witness thereof, the parties to this MOA through their duly authorized representatives have executed this MOA on the days and dates set out below, and certify that they have read, understood, and agreed to the terms and conditions of this MOA as set forth herein.

The effective date of this MOA is the date of the last signature affixed to this page."

If that leaves a large blank spot on the previous page, we need to insert:

THE REMAINDER OF THIS PAGE LEFT INTENTIONALLY BLANK

In that blank spot.

Also, as a final formatting, I would try not to split paragraphs between pages, particularly if it leaves only one or two lines orphaned. While this isn't always possible, it should be done to the extent possible.
