Alan,

I am working on a response to your email regarding site emissions but it will likely be next week before I finish the calculations.

Regarding the Archeology MOA, we still have significant concerns with Section A1. When this section is strictly read it can be interpreted to mean that no construction will be allowed site wide until the recovery program is completed. The early site construction will not be near the archeology site, some construction will be more than a mile away, and therefore we believe we should be able to begin construction that will not impact the archeology site. Is it possible to revise the language to something like the following:

"Prior to the commencement of surface disturbing activities within 200 feet of site 48SW16604, the data recovery program shall be implemented by LCI in accordance with the Treatment Plan prepared by Centennial Archaeology, Inc., dated January 2008, and incorporated into this MOA by reference."

Sorry for this delay but we believe this could be a significant issue and it is therefore best to address it now.
