Melissa- We have reviewed the PIAA analysis for sage grouse core area provided by John Cash of UR energy for the South Lost Ck exploration project. To our best determination, the analysis is complete and accurate. The data presented demonstrate that this project falls within the guidelines provided by this summer's Sage Grouse Implementation Team, including less than 1 well pad per 640 acre average density and less than 5% surface disturbance. We also approve of the sage grouse monitoring plan that is in place.
