This is in response to a request for the National Park Service's (NPS) review and comment on the PSEG Early Site Permit Application for Artificial Island, Lower Alloways Creek in New Jersey.

The National Park Service offers the following comments:

There are two Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) sites within a 6-mile radius of the proposed project located in Delaware. It does not appear that the project will directly affect the Delaware LWCF sites. However, if new transmission lines were to cross the river, they could potentially impact these LWCF sites, depending upon placement. See the attached map for locations of the LWCF properties within the 6-mile radius of the proposal.
