I spoke to Donna Grace in regards to a letter that was received on October 5, 2010. The letter, dated September 25, 2003, was addressed to Delaware Health and Social Services and was an amendment request to add a mobile PET coach to their Delaware licenses. Looking through the history of the license, the licensee did not amend their NRC license to add NARM after the NRC took control of NARM from the State of DE. However, they did terminate the use of the mobile PET service and it was referenced during a June 2010 amendment of the NRC license. The licensee had been concerned that they had never amended their license for NARM use so they subsequently sent in a letter with their initial request to the State of DE to add PET. They only had the one PET trailer and it has now been removed from service. All sealed sources from the trailer are in storage at the Newark location. This letter was just for follow-up information and was not an amendment request. All PET use had previously been removed from the license during the last amendment.
