Dear Mr. Laisure:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 04 to your NRC Material License No. 21-23396-02 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please note that we modified your license by updating Subitem Nos. 7.A, 7.B, 8.A, and 8.B. We also added a Condition No. 12.F and updated Condition No. 15, as it appeared on Amendment No. 03 of your license. These changes should enhance your awareness of the radiation safety program elements in your license and our regulatory requirements.

Please note we removed Condition Nos. 13 and 18, as they appeared on Amendment No. 03, from your license. Condition No. 13 is redundant now that your license has possession limits. Condition 18 is also redundant as we updated Condition No. 17, as it appeared on your Amendment No. 03 of your license. These changes also required that subsequent conditions in your license be renumbered.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
