SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Mr. Camparone:

In letters dated May 14, 2010 (with attachments), May 20, 2010 (with attachments), September 8, 2010 (with attachments), NRC Form 314 dated May 14, 2010 and NRC Form 314 dated May 20, 2010, you indicated that you wished to release the location at 731 S. Lafayette Street, South Bend, Indiana for unrestricted use.

You also indicated that all activities authorized by license number 13-15423-03 have ceased and that radioactive materials possessed under this license have been transferred to CPN International, Inc. under California License No. 1100-07, and Surveying Solutions, Inc. under NRC License No. 21-32687-01.

The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your former location of use and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required for this location and it is suitable for unrestricted use.


Based on these conditions, your NRC license number 13-15423-03 is hereby terminated.
