I would personally like to request that the deadline for commenting on the Draft Environmental Assessment (Draft EA) for renewal of Nuclear Fuel Services' (NFS) Special Nuclear Materials license be extended by 90 days.

Due to the unprecedented proposed action whereby the licensee is requesting an additional forty years, it would seem the public would have a wider window in which to review and process the Draft EA.
