The purpose of this letter is to provide updated schedule information for the Environmental Report (ER) related changes resulting from responses to RAI 254 and RAI 255. RAI 254 and RAI 255 address Liquid Waste Management and Gaseous Waste Management, as discussed in Sections 11.2 and 11.3 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 6.

The reference provided a December 15, 2010 date for ER-related changes resulting from the responses to RAI 254 and RAI 255. As UniStar Nuclear Energy is required to provide an annual COLA update, the ER-related changes resulting from the responses to RAI 254 and RAI 255 will be included in the transmittal of CCNPP Unit 3 COLA, Revision 7 by December 31, 2010.
