Mr. Miller contacted a member of the Licensing Assistance Team and requested information on what needed to be done in order to terminate the license. I looked over the license and noted that the licensee was authorized for carbon-14 and tritium and therefore would be required to perform surveys during the decommissioning process. Mr. Miller informed me that a consultant had been hired and would complete analyze of the wipes by early February 2011. The decision to terminate the license and stop all licensed activity was made on or about November 17, 2010. The licensee agreed to send in a notification letter in accordance with 10 CFR 30.36 and to inform the NRC that a request to terminate the license with supporting documentation would be sent when it becomes available.
