



If the Davis-Besse nuclear power plant license is renewed without resolving the Petitioner's safety and environmental concerns, this nuclear power plant may operate unsafely and pose an unacceptable risk to the environment and the public health and safety of the Petitioner's member who lives, recreates and has business within the affected vicinity of the nuclear power reactor. I am concerned that if an accident were to occur at Davis-Besse nuclear power plant, I might be killed, injured or sickened by the radioactive releases.
