Dr. Kolodziej,

You are required by regulation to provide financial assurance for this license, as you have been informed by letter, telephone, and email on multiple occasions since December 7, 2009. To date, we have not received any response from you that either provides financial assurance for this license, or provides a schedule of activities you are performing in order to obtain financial assurance for this license with an estimated date of completion, as has been requested. In addition, you have not provided

sufficient data to demonstrate that financial assurance would not be required. Based on our experience with all other accelerators that we have licensed, activation products are produced in quantities that require provision of financial assurance.

If we do not receive a response from you within 7 days informing us of your activities to obtain financial assurance, we will initiate enforcement activities because you appear to be in violation of the regulations.

Dr. Kolodziej,

As was described in our letter to you dated December 9, 2009, the guidance for acceptable financial assurance can be found in the regulations of 10 CFR 30.35 and NUREG-1757, Volume 3, chapter 4 and the associated appendices.

10 CFR 30.35(b)(1) requires you to provide financial assurance and a decommissioning funding plan (DFP) for the quantities of unsealed byproduct materials with half-lives greater than 120 days that you are authorized to possess. Your DFP must include a decommissioning cost estimate and financial assurance for the estimated amount. The NUREG-1757, Volume 3, "Consolidated NMSS Decommissioning Guidance; Financial Assurance, Recordkeeping, and Timeliness" (NUREG-1757,

Volume 3) provides guidance in Chapter 4. The current NUREG-1757, Volume 3 guidance can be found on the NRC website using the following URL: <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1757/v3/>

The guidance in NUREG-1757, Volume 3, includes acceptable wording for the various types of financial assurance that are allowed by the NRC (trust funds, escrow accounts, government funds, CDs, government securities, sureties, letters of credit, lines of credit, insurance policies, parent company guarantees, self-guarantees, external sinking funds, and standby trust funds). You may not be eligible for all types, so need to review the criteria for each. However, prior to selecting the type of financial instrument, you must first develop your DFP and have the cost estimate approved. Guidance on developing the DFP also is in NUREG-1757, Volume 3.

Dr. Kolodziej,

As stated in our letter to you dated February 9, 2010, you are required to provide financial assurance for the International Cyclotron License No. 52-31352-02. This was a follow-up letter to our letter dated December 7, 2009 and your response dated December 21, 2009. This was also discussed with David Rhoe on March 22, 2010. In addition, I have been trying to reach you by telephone on multiple occasions this past month.

As stated in the letter, we cannot reduce your license possession limits without an adequate technical basis which demonstrates that you do not actually possess long-lived radioactive materials in the amounts authorized on your license. If that basis is not provided, you must submit a decommissioning funding plan and appropriate financial assurance for this license.

Please contact me if you have any questions. Please respond within 30 days with a schedule of your expected steps to submit the required information.
