Reference 1 requested that NRC suspend the review of the Callaway Plant Unit 2 COL Application and requested that the NRC Staff suspend all activities relating to the COLA. References 2 and 3 provided follow-up responses to RIS 2010-01, and also informed the Staff that we will be pursuing filing of an Early Site Permit ("ESP") application for the Callaway Plant Site.

The purpose of this letter is to request the Staff open a new project and perform pre-application activities in support of a future ESP filing. Initial activities would include, but not be limited to, assembling environmental issues that had not been previously transmitted to us at the time of suspension of the COLA review. More specifically, we would like to get access to items identified from the Callaway Unit 2 COLA Environmental Site Audit. We would like to have those review items be made available to us, so we can factor them into the ESP application and improve its overall quality.

We will accept charges generated as a result of pre-application review activities.
