Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) submitted a Combined License (COL) Application for two AP1000 pressurized water reactor units to be located at the Turkey Point site, designated Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 (PTN 6 & 7), located in Miami-Dade County, FL on June 30, 2009 (Reference 1). FPL submitted the first annual update to the PTN 6 & 7 COL Application on September 3, 2010, (References 2 and 3).

This letter provides Revision 2 to the Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 (PTN 6 & 7) COL Application. The updates provided with this letter include the early submittal of the annual update of the docketed Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR) and the semi-

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annual update of the Departures Report (COL Application, Part 2 and Part 7, respectively) as required by 10 CFR 50.71(e)(3)(iii) and 10 CFR Part 52, Appendix D, subsection X.B, respectively. The annual update of the FSAR would normally be due by September 3, 2011. The semi-annual update of the Departures Report would normally be due in March 2011. Additionally, Parts 1, 3, 4, 5, 8, and 10 of the PTN 6 & 7 COL Application are also updated with Revision 2. Although there are no changes in Parts 6, 9, and 11, these Parts have been changed to Revision 2 for consistency with the remainder of the COL Application.

Revision 2 incorporates the revised FSAR Sections 2.5.1, 2.5.2, and 2.5.3 provided by FPL on September 3, 2010 (Reference 4). Revision 2 adopts changes to schedule, construction cost estimates, decommissioning cost estimates, and decommissioning funding related to the construction and commercial operation schedule update. This revision includes changes identified by previous FPL correspondence, including responses to requests for additional information (RAI), conforming changes to the FSAR, miscellaneous errata items, and standard and plant specific changes identified since the Revision 1 submittal. Revisions to the COL Application are identified by revision bars in the right margin for text and tables and by the revision number for figures.

FPL submitted the Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 Mitigative Strategies Description and Plans (MSD), Revision 0, required by 10 CFR 52.80(d) on December 6, 2010, (Reference 5). The Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 MSD, Revision 0 and conforming changes to the applicable Parts of the COL Application, including withdrawing the exemption request for the MSD in COL Application Part 7, will be provided in a future COL Application update.

This PTN 6 & 7 COL Application update contains no Restricted Data or other defense information requiring separation in accordance with 10 CFR 50.33(j). Part 9 contains state and local radiological emergency plans designated as "Sensitive-Federal, State, Foreign Government, and International Agency Controlled." Part 9 also includes the FPL PTN 6 & 7 Cyber Security Plan (CSP), Revision 0, designated as Security-Related Information, and accordingly FPL requests that the Part 9 be withheld from public disclosure under 10 CFR 2.390. Part 8, Physical Security Plan (PSP), contains safeguards information as defined in 10 CFR 73.22 and is being submitted by FPL Letter L-2010-290 (Reference 6).

Consistent with common licensing practice and the original FPL COL Application, most of the updated application text is written in the present tense, active voice, including discussions of facilities and programs not yet built or implemented. Exceptions to this approach are the discussions of operating experience and completed studies and evaluations, which are written in the past tense. It should be understood, however, that statements regarding facilities (e.g., structures, systems, and components) and pre-construction, pre-operational, and operational activities (e.g., procedures and programs) typically address facilities and activities that have not yet been built or performed and will not be built or performed until it is reasonable and appropriate to do so.

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Enclosure 1 provides a Revision 2 summary for each Part of the COL Application. A roadmap document identifying each change and basis is being prepared as an aid to the NRC reviewers and will be submitted in January 2011.


