Hi Steve,

Well, "shortly" in Uranium One time seems to be days, weeks, months instead of seconds, minutes, hours! Sorry I'm so late with a response ...

We just submitted our budget to Vancouver yesterday, and the following is our plan. Because NRC services are very expensive, and we have to guess at the amount you will charge each quarter, we have to be a little tight with our NRC submittals. So:

1. Resubmit Ludeman: our target is to resubmit the Ludeman Application (page replacements if approved by NRC) by the end of this year.
2. Resume JAB/Antelope review: our plan is to resume the NRC review in Q3 of 2011 (July forward). We first want to contract and submit a wildlife management plan to Wyoming DEQ and Game & Fish Department for their review and approval (sage grouse plan, as JAB/Antelope are in a Core Habitat Area) during Q4 of this year and the first 6 months of 2011. The new monitoring plan and any facility location(s) changes will be incorporated into our applications (both NRC and WDEQ). We want to make sure that we do not encounter any problems with the sage grouse and our development plan prior to asking NRC to resume the review.
3. Application to combine Moore Ranch into Irigaray license ... target submittal is the end of Q1 2011.

Also, Jon Winter says that they are about 99% through with the Irigaray (SUA-1341) license renewal, so that should be coming your way no later than the end of this month. Our response has only taken 8 months?? .... And we thought you guys were slow ...☺

Plus, Allemand-Ross is still targeted for December 2010 submittal. Our delay there is the baseline hydrology work ... we are challenged by how to get rid of our ore body pump test water that is very high in radium-226 content. We've not had much help from the State on that one, and we are still working on a solution.

I hope that I have not missed anything major. Do you need letters of intent on anything, or are we covered?
