Contract NRC-10-08-405 is hereby modified as follows:

5.5

- 1. The method of payment for the parking spaces used by the NRC will change as of January 1, 2011. Up to this date, NRC employees paid month of the monthly parking fee to the contractor via payroll deduction payments, and the NRC paid the remaining monthly supplement cost under the contract via electronic funds transfer. As of January 1, 2011, NRC employee payroll deduction payments will no longer be made to the contractor. Instead, the entire monthly parking fee will be paid by the NRC under this contract via electronic funds transfer.
- 2. The attached Statement of Work has been revised to show the change in payment method described above, and to revise the contract cost estimate.
- 3. Option Year Three is exercised, from January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011, in accordance with FAR Clause 52.217-9 Option to Extend the Term of the Contract.
- 4. The ceiling of the contract is increased by \$141,120.00, from \$70,000.00 to \$211,120.00. The total value of the contract is increased by \$218,040.00, from \$141,400.00 to \$359,440.00. The revised current ceiling, which includes the base period and option years one, two, and three, as well as the total value of the contract, is as follows:

- 5. Invoicing and payment will be made only for spaces that are being used by the NRC during a monthly billing period. As of January 1, 2011, paces will be used by the NRC for parkers, plus one space for one government vehicle, for a total of a spaces. As of January 1, 2011, invoicing under the contract should be for a spaces x and seach per month = per month. This amount will fluctuate from month to month as parking spaces used by NRC employees may be added or subtracted.
- 6. Incremental funding is added in the amount of \$93,000.00, thereby increasing the obligated amount from \$70,000.00 to \$163,000.00.

Accordingly, the contract is hereby modified as follows:

- 1. Section B.1 Consideration and Obligation Firm Fixed Price, is hereby revised as follows:
 - "The firm fixed price of this contract is \$359,440.00."
- 2. Section B.2 Duration of the Contract Period Alternate 2, is hereby revised as follows:

"This contract shall commence on June 30, 2008 and will expire on December 31, 2011. The term of this contract may be extended at the option of the Government for one additional year."

STATEMENT OF WORK

Revised as of January 1, 2011 (Modification No. 6 to Contract NRC-10-08-405)

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) will require up to a maximum of 120 garage parking spaces for NRC employees working at 12300 Twinbrook Parkway, Rockville, Maryland from the building parking management contractor, Central Parking System. NRC will pay the parking fee directly to the Contractor based on the number of spaces actually used during a monthly billing period.

Requirements:

- Access cards and an annual parking permit to gain access into the building and garage. The
 Contractor will process new parking requests, or subtract parkers, upon receipt of a written notice
 from the NRC Project Officer in the form of an electronic mail notification or facsimile.
- Central Parking System will be responsible for invoicing NRC for the full cost of the parking used.
- Invoices must include the contract number NRC-10-08-405, clearly state the month for which billing is being submitted, include a listing of NRC employees by name for whom billing is being submitted, and include the monthly rate being charged for each employee.
- Method for replacing lost access cards or stolen annual parking permits

Period of Performance

The period of performance includes a six month base period with four one-year option periods.
 The NRC will contact the Contractor before the end of the last option period regarding the possibility of renewing this agreement depending on the length of the building lease.

The contract cost estimate is as follows:

Base Period, June 30, 2008 – December 31, 2008 — \$7,000.00

Option Year 1, January 1, 2009 – December 31, 2009, 70 spaces x \$30 each x 12 months = \$25,200.00

Option Year 2, January 1, 2010 – December 31, 2010, 90 spaces x \$35 each x 12 months = \$37,800.00

Invoicing and payment will be made only for spaces that are being used by the NRC during a monthly billing period. As of January 1, 2011, 76 spaces will be used by the NRC for 76 parkers, plus one space for one government vehicle, for a total of 77 spaces: As of January 1, 2011, monthly payment under the contract will be for 77 spaces x \$95 each per month = \$7,315.00 per month. This amount will fluctuate as parking spaces used by NRC employees may be added or subtracted from month to month.
