Subject: Re: NRC Proceeding "Turkey Point 52-040 and 52-041-COL"

CASE/Citizens Allied for Safe Energy, Inc., a pro se intervenor, hereby requests from the appropriate individuals/organizations copied on this memo, their agreement to an extension of two weeks (14 calendar days) beyond the required September 20, 2010 response date for the following reasons:

- 1) Expert witnesses and advisors in the preparation of the petition and related contentions reside in Miami and elsewhere in Florida and throughout the nation. Sufficient time is required to contact them and prepare meaningful responses to the concerns raised by the NRC staff and by FPL representatives.
- 2) The response from the NRC staff was not sent until 4:53 PM on September 13, 2010 so that day was unavailable for consideration of the response.
- 3) Friday and Saturday, September 17 and 18th, 2010 are religious holidays for several of our preparers and advisors so those days are not available to them as work days.
- 4) Taking the points in 2) and 3) together, the net amount of time available for CASE to prepare a response is reduced to four days.
- 5) The responses by the NRC staff and by the FPL representative are quite lengthy and will require more time than has been allowed and which is realistically available to CASE.
- 6) CASE has not filed a pro se intervention before so the procedures and forms which might be quite familiar to others are less so to CASE so a little more preparation time will be required.

CASE, therefore, is requesting agreement by all parties to an extension until at least October 4, 2010 to file a response in this matter.
