SUBJECT: UPDATE TO DECOMMISSIONING FINANCIAL ASSURANCE DOCUMENTS

Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) licensees are required to update their decommissioning cost estimates (DCE) at intervals not to exceed 3 years in accordance with 10 CFR 30.35(e). Changes to the DCE will require an update to the financial assurance instrument (i.e., Statement of Intent letter, Letter of Credit, Surety Bond, or other surety instrument). If the licensee provides surety by means of a Letter of Credit or a Surety Bond then an update to the Standby Trust Agreement is also needed.

The NRC has reviewed your docket file and has identified that the following document needs to be updated and submitted to the NRC for review and approval.

1. Standby Trust Agreement needs to reflect the amount of \$113,000 in Appendix A.

The NRC provides guidance on financial assurance in NUREG-1757, Volume 3, "Consolidated NMSS Decommissioning: Financial Assurance, Recordkeeping and Timeliness", which can be found at: <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1757/>. You are being requested to provide these updated documents within 45 days from receipt of this letter.
