Marshfield Clinic and Ministry St. Joseph's Hospital respectfully submit the comments below on
the above referenced proposed rule to Physical Protection of Byproduct Material.

Section 37.25(a)(6) requires credit history evaluation to include review and evaluation of all
information that is provided by a national credit-reporting agency about the individual's credit
history including financial responsibilities from countries other than the United States.

Marshfield Clinic and Ministry St. Joseph's Hospital respectfully disagree with conducting credit
history checks. What information from a credit history is relevant to approving whether an
employee is deemed trustworthy and reliable to have unescorted access? How do we interpret
and evaluate the credit history? Will there be guidelines on how to obtain this information from
other countries assuming credit histories are available and reliable? Would the cost of obtaining
such records truly justify the information that would be received? We believe not. Deeming an
individual unreliable and untrustworthy based off a credit history doesn't seem justifiable for a
patient care setting. During the difficult economic times over the past several years, a credit
history may not truly reflect a person's trustworthy and reliability status. Furthermore, we do not
perform credit checks on any other staff who also hold important roles in the organizations.
Marshfield Clinic and Ministry St. Joseph's Hospital disagree with the use of credit history
checks and believe they should be removed from the proposed rule.
