Please note that updated your NRC Material License by adding Condition No. 18. This is standard license condition that appeared to be missing on your license. Condition No. 18 provides authorization for the initial mounting of gauges "IF" the certificate of registration issued by the NRC or an Agreement State permits it. Other requirements that must be followed are also listed in Condition No. 18.

As a reminder, all documentation sent to the NRC must include a legible signature. This is required to ensure the security of our licensees and protect the licenses we administer, please legibly sign your complete first and last name for all future correspondence.



This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.
