Dear Mr. Hackmann:

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources hereby Approves the Removal Action Work Plan For Building Demolition; Rev 3 dated December 3, 2010 and submitted on December 7, 2010.

The work, as described by your staff, includes a preference for dismantling no more parts of the structures than can be loaded into containers for shipment within the same day. Stockpiling of materials on-site will be minimized. If stockpiling occurs, they will be:

1. Kept within appropriate storage buildings, containers, or left within the footprint of the structures being demolished (and covered when not in use).
2. Contact water from dust suppression and rain water will be collected for testing and potential treatment prior to discharge.

All material from the buildings will be disposed at out-of-state properly licensed facilities. Recycling and reuse will not occur. Contact water from dust suppression and rain water within the demolition areas will be collected for testing and potential treatment prior to discharge.

Please note, our Approval of this document pertains to the description of demolition work and is not an approval of statements regarding which buildings are deemed by Westinghouse to not be contaminated. Other documentation and approvals to release any of the buildings from further remediation and decommissioning still must be submitted for review.

**List of Tasks to be completed in preparation for Building Demolition**  
**Per discussions with Westinghouse Staff**

1. Asbestos NESHAP Notification of Demolition and Renovation Application Form 780-1923 and pertinent documentation have been submitted by DEMCO to our Air Pollution Control Program. Any requests by our Air Pollution Control Program must be resolved prior to beginning work.
2. Provide maps of storm water diversion and collection structures. This should be accompanied by a description of water management procedures.
3. Incorporate changes, into the storm water management and monitoring procedures resulting from the current review of modifications to NPDES Permit MO-0000761.
4. Provide notification to the public, via the project newsletter, of the upcoming work.
5. Provide preparatory training and work briefings to staff conducting demolition tasks. (Briefings also to be provided to regulatory field staff.)
6. Confirm compliance with local government expectations for beginning demolition activities.
