Preliminarily, the inspectors determined the plant responded as designed with no complications or additional safety issues.

The inspectors walked down the safety related areas of the plant including the 480V room, the auxiliary feedwater pump room, control room, and the area surrounding the 21 main transformer. The inspectors did not identify any safety related equipment issues.

A couple items to note:

- 1. The 480V room dampers close on a transformer deluge activation. This occurred as designed. Room temperature peaked around 100F with the limit being 104F. The licensee has compensatory measures in place including opening doors (with security present) and running fairs.
- 2. A water/oil mixture was unexpectedly found in the turbine building on the other side of the wall from the transformer, but did not affect any equipment.
