URENCO USA Corporate Overview



- Safety and Quality remain the guiding principles over the URENCO USA site.
 - At the end of 2010, we reached 10.9 million safe work hours-to-date with no construction lost-time injuries.
- As of January 4th, 2011, LES has 304 employees, including 9 seconded and 4 interns.
- Our annual payroll for 2011 is expected to be around \$30 million.

URENCO USA Update Project Phase I



Major 2011 Focus Areas for Phase I (1.6M SWU) include:

- Continue installation of centrifuge cascades in the Domenici Separations Building (continues through 2011)
- Complete construction of the Separation Building Module 1001 Extension (Civil construction expected to be substantially completed by April)
- Complete construction of the Cylinder Receipt and Dispatch Building (Civil construction expected to be substantially completed by May).

URENCO USA Update (cont.)

Project Phase II



Major 2011 Focus Areas for Phase II (3.7M SWU) include:

- Complete Centrifuge Assembly Building Expansion (NRC approved, ETC shared access milestone met)
- The Separation Building Module 1003 Design is complete and construction has commenced.
- The workforce will hold at approximately 650 craft and construction support personnel, but will be adjusted, based on planned work load.

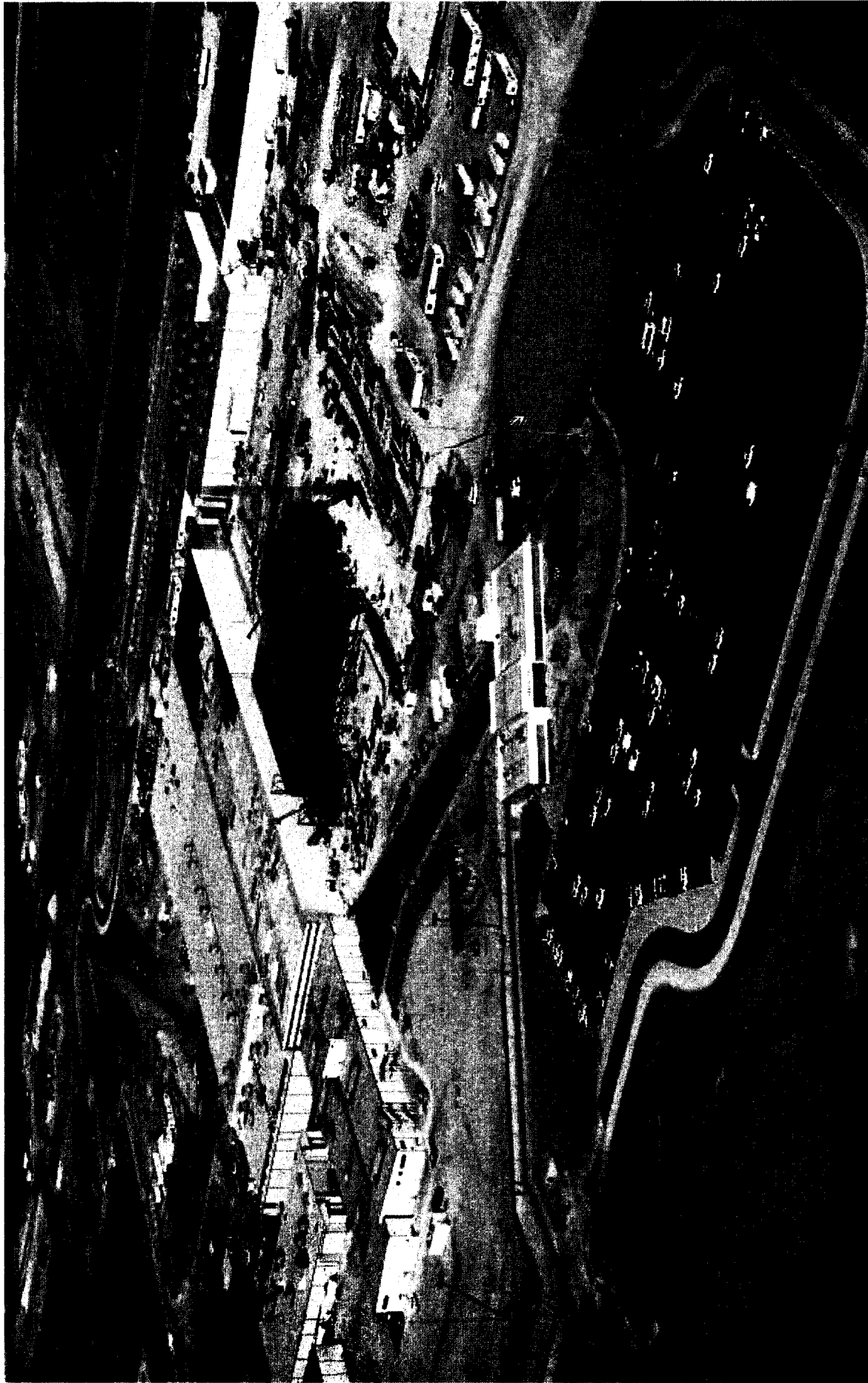

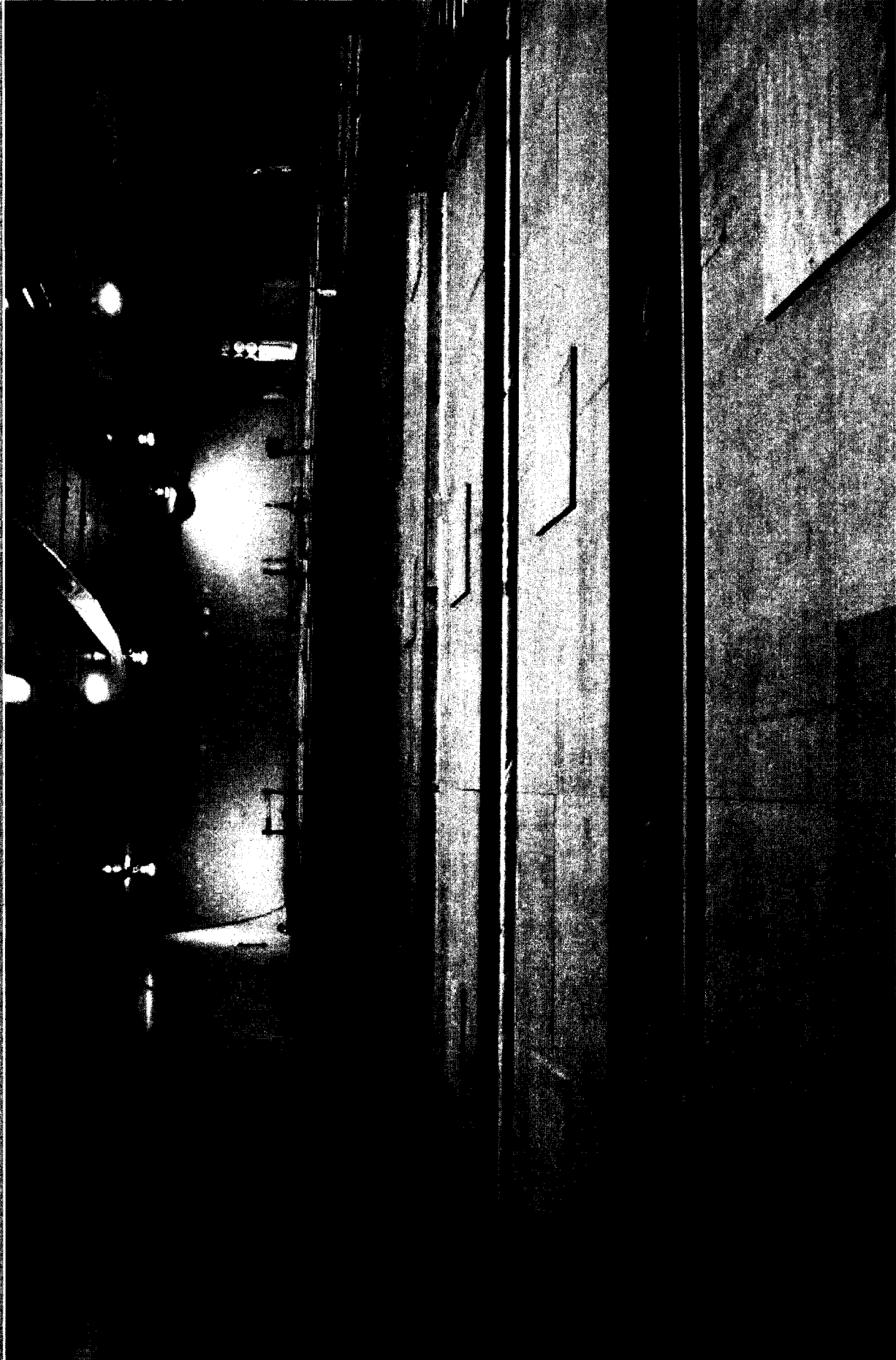
Aerial View of Construction February 2010

Uranium By-Product Storage Pad





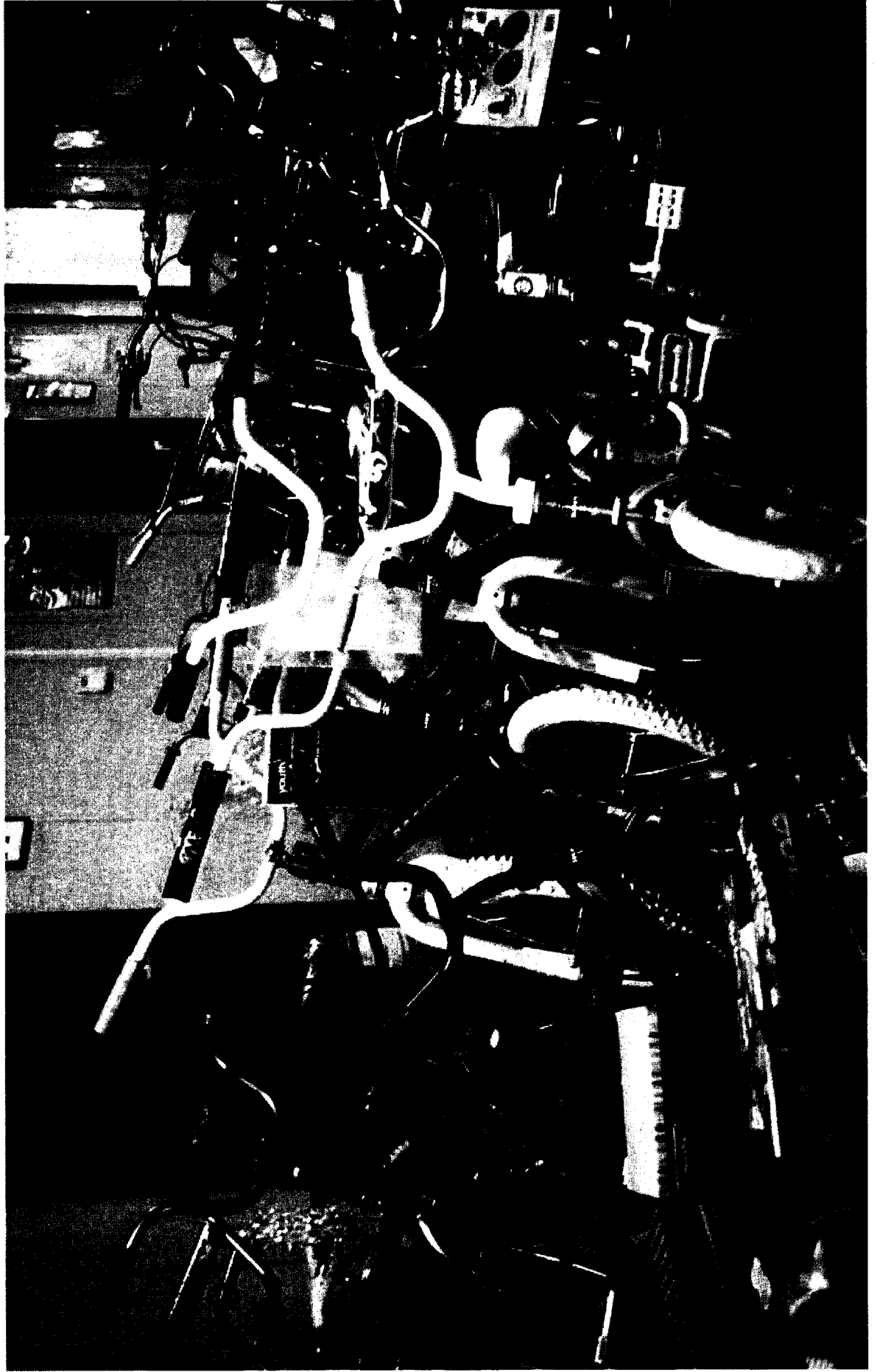

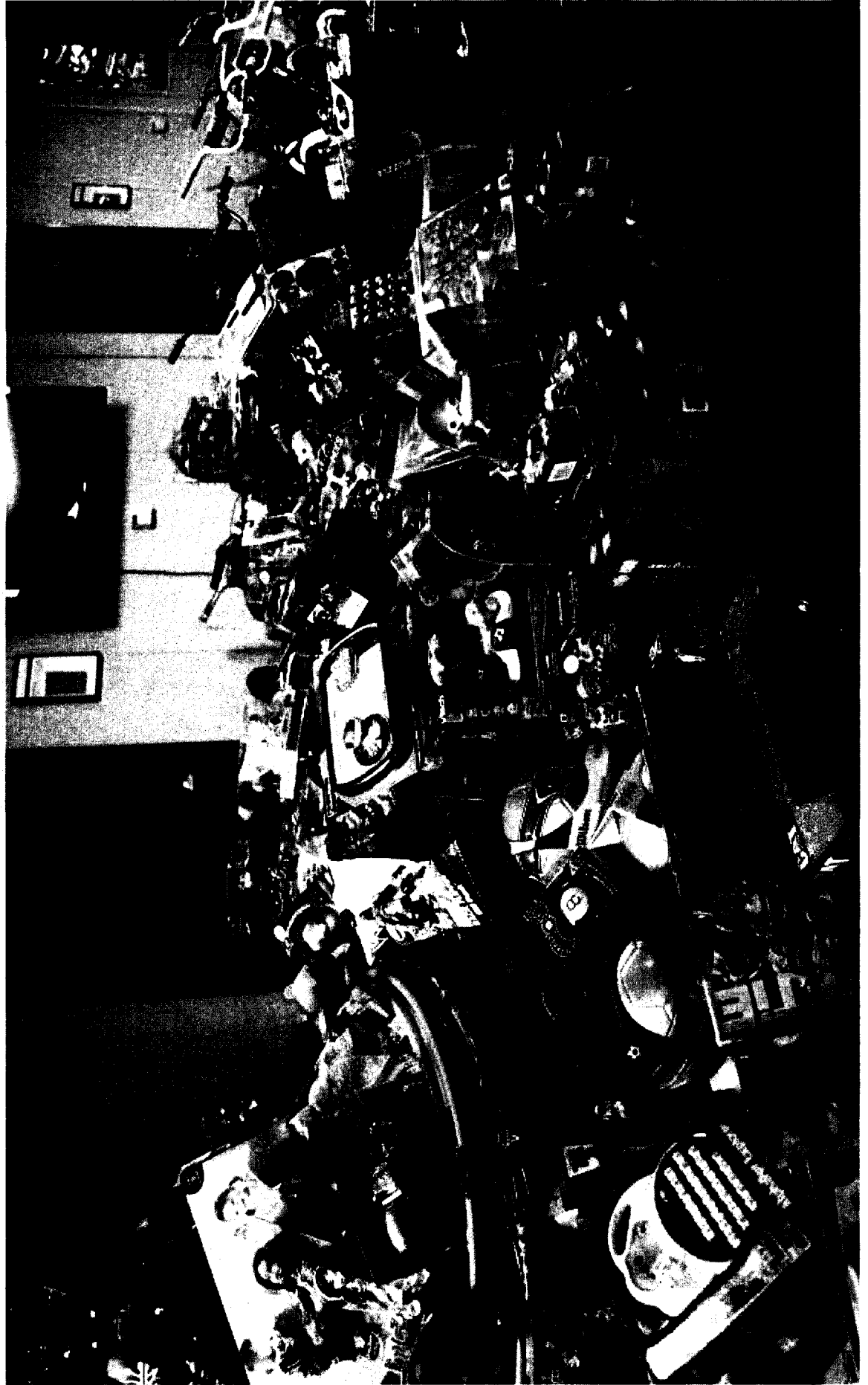

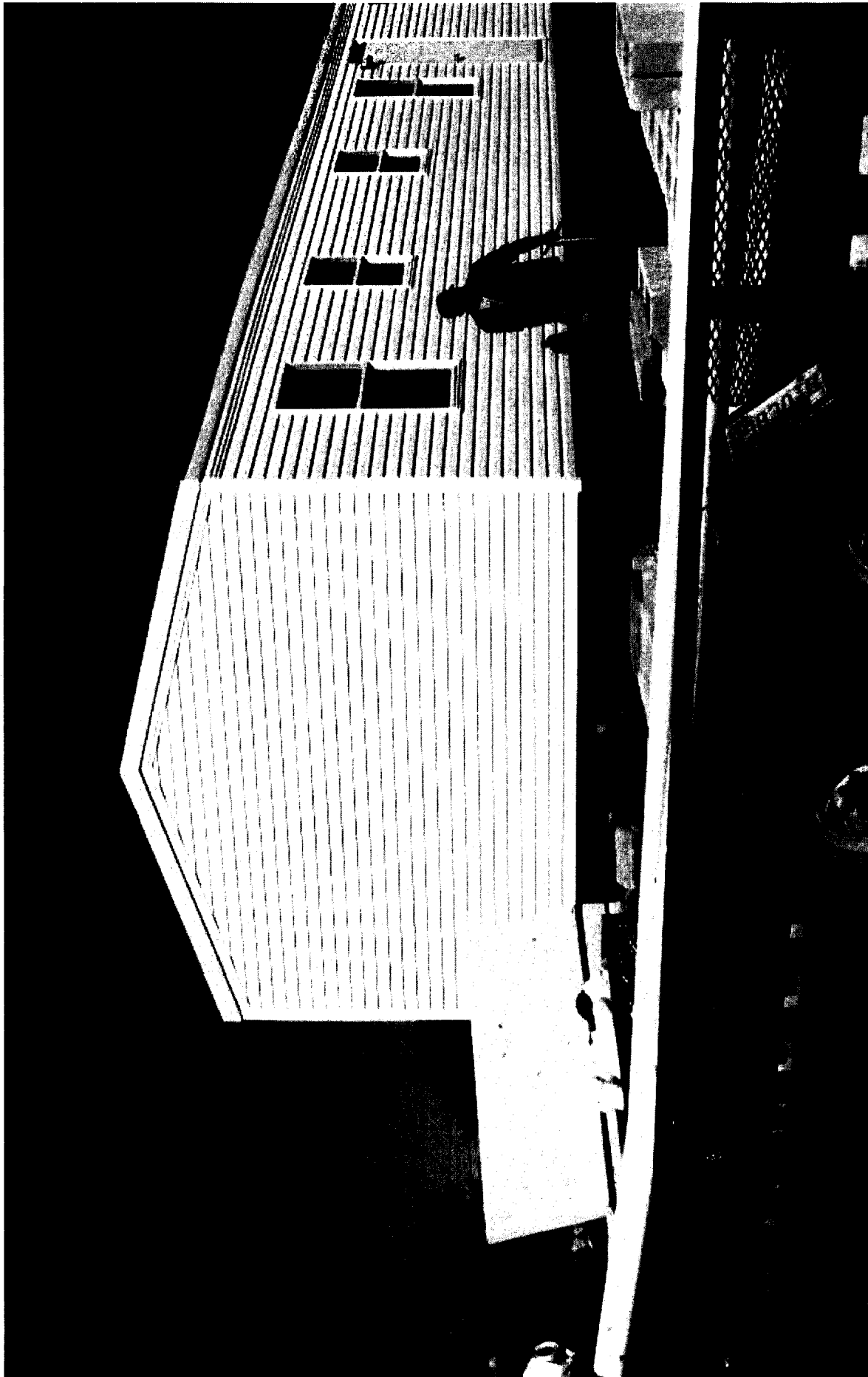
