

## EP RULE/GUIDANCE IMPLEMENTATION WORKSHOPS PROPOSED DESIGN

<b>Number:</b>	One workshop in each FEMA region for both onsite/offsite and onsite only EP topics listed below (for licensees, applicants, and offsite response organizations) + one workshop in DC area for onsite only EP topics (for licensees and applicants) (Option: One workshop in each NRC region + one workshop in DC area for both onsite/offsite and onsite only EP topics)	
<b>Length:</b>	2 days for workshop addressing both onsite/offsite and onsite only EP topics (10 hours for onsite/offsite EP topics + 8 hours for onsite EP topics) 1 day for workshop addressing onsite only EP topics (8 hours)	
<b>Timeframe:</b>	Conduct 1-2 workshops per week beginning 2-4 weeks after EP final rule publication, with 1 <sup>st</sup> workshop conducted in DC area (Option: Conduct 1-2 workshops per week beginning immediately after EP final rule publication, with 1 <sup>st</sup> workshop conducted in DC area)	
<b>Remote access:</b>	Each workshop accessible via telephone and internet	
<b>Topical areas:</b>	<u>Onsite only EP topics (time allotted)</u>	<u>Onsite/offsite EP topics (time allotted)</u>
