NASA Marshall Space Flight Center (MSFC) requests an amendment to NRC Material License 01-06571-01 to reinstate a location for Depleted Uranium (DU). Building 4612 where the lab for the material is housed was to be demolished and the lab immediately moved to Building 4602. However, due to budgetary restraints building 4602 will not be ready for occupancy for an extended time and the researchers wish to start work as soon as possible. Therefore we ask that 4612 be added back to the license as a DU use area. All parameters and controls for the Building 4612 lab are the same as before.
