Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

This letter concerns GNF-A's response to NRC Enforcement Action (EA) 09-268 on July 23, 2010 (Reference 4). NRC Staff reviewed the response and determined GNF-A adequately identified root causes and initiated corrective actions to prevent recurrence (Reference 5).


GNF-A has made significant progress on addressing issues identified in the Notice of Violation and has completed the analytical work for the first scheduled milestone. The revised ISA documentation for this milestone has addressed the programmatic issues for this portion of our facility. To confirm the adequacy of that work, GNF-A obtained independent reviews and has received comments that need to be resolved. Both of these reviews have been completed and the results are being prioritized and addressed. As a result, it will take an additional period of time of approximately 60 days to resolve these comments before we complete the first milestone and report the results to NRC.
