## SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Dr. Hall:

In your letter dated August 18, 2010 to Sherry Buda and in letter dated January 11, 2011 signed by William Crozier, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license. The NRC staff has reviewed your final status of the nickel-63 electron capture detector once in your possession. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number is hereby terminated.
