Terry,

Attached is a simple table summarizing the number of components making up the LRA.

Just so that it's clear, here's a quick breakdown of the attached table:

- There were 145,102 components that were evaluated as part of the LRA process. These originated from 86 different plant systems. From these plant systems, they were broken into 64 different LRIDs.
- Of the 145,102 components, 54,557 were not within the scope of license renewal (and subsequently not subject to aging management review). The remaining 90,545 components were within the scope of license renewal.
- Of the 90,545 in-scope components, 44,884 were not subject to aging management review (i.e. they were either active or short-lived)
- Of the 90,545 in-scope components, 45,661 were subject to aging management review. These are the components that make up the Chapter 2 tables and Chapter 3 tables of the LRA.

I hope this helps. If you want a breakdown of these numbers by system, I can get you that. But I would be surprised if the public meeting would be appropriate for this level of detail. Just let me know..
