Presently, Tom Pham serves as the Senior Safeguards Technical Analyst in the Material Control and Accounting Branch of the Division of Fuel Cycle Safety and Safeguards within the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards. Tom received his Master's degree in Chemistry from the University of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. From 1979-1990, he worked in the private industry sector for Westinghouse Electric Corporation at the Pittsburgh Science and Technology Center (formerly R&D Center), then at the Columbia Nuclear Fuel Manufacturing Plant of the Westinghouse Commercial Nuclear Fuel Division. Since 1990, he joined the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) at its Headquarters in Rockville, Maryland, working in the safeguards area of material control and accounting (MC&A) for inspection and licensing programs, guidance development, and rulemakings.
