Mr. Kenneth Kline is a financial analyst with the Special Projects Branch with over twelve years of work experience. He has been with the NRC for 3 years. He serves as FSME's lead financial assurance advisor with responsibilities that include:

- 1) Managing financial assurance functions for FSME;
- 2) Serving as expert point of contact for NRC's Regional Offices and Agreement States pertaining to reviewing licensing financial reporting requirements in accordance with MD 8.12; NUREG-1757, Vol. 3; 10 CFR 30.35; 10 CFR 40.36; 10 CFR 50.75; 10 CFR 50.82; 10 CFR 70.25; and Crit. 9 and 10 of App. A to 10 CFR Part 40;
- 3) Evaluating licensing financial, accounting and reporting requirements;
- 4) Mentoring/training new staff members; and
- 5) Providing expert advice, consultation and guidance on a broad variety of matters involving financial qualifications, decommissioning funding assurance, transfer of control (including foreign ownership) and antitrust issues.

Mr. Kline works on financial reviews for various facilities to support FSME's Reactor Decommissioning Branch, including Special Nuclear Material applications, Uranium Recovery facilities and other materials sites. This includes licensing, relicensing, license transfers, and other appropriate license amendments and exemption requests. He provides authoritative policy advice and guidance with regard to relevant statutes, regulations and orders to management and staff on financial/economic matters.

As a financial analyst for NRC, he analyzes changing markets and operational conditions. He provides analysis, consultation and advice to management and staff on banking, financial, marketing, technical and economic matters.

Prior to joining the NRC, Mr. Kline worked for the United States Department of Transportation in the Maritime Administration (2000~2007) as a Transportation Industry Analyst. In this position, he served as a team leader and was responsible for an office Financial Group. He was the project manager for multi-million dollar utility projects, and performed Management Control Reviews of various agency programs. He led negotiations with private-sector entities, and
